Hawthorne Housing will be accepting applications **online only** for its Section 8 Waiting List beginning: June 15, 2017 at 8:00am and closing on June 16, 2017 at 5:30p.m.

When funding is available we will only serve: Elderly living in Hawthorne (62+), Disabled persons living in Hawthorne, Veterans living in Hawthorne, and Residents of Hawthorne. All preferences must be met at the time of application.

Due to limited funding, applications will be selected and ordered using a random lottery system for those with the above listed preferences to create an equitable process. The time and date of receipt of the application online has no bearing on whether an application will be selected for the waiting list. There is no need or advantage to applying immediately after the list opens; In fact, those who do may experience slower response times or limited availability from the on-line system. There are no immediate openings for new applicants in the program- those with the above listed preferences will be considered once funding is available.
