SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON APPROVING A MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH LOS ANGELES COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEARS 2019-2020 THROUGH 2023-2024

SUMMARY

Council will consider approving a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Municipal Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the County of Los Angeles for the provision of law enforcement services by the Sheriff's Department within the municipal boundaries of the City of Compton and approving the contract for the following Fiscal Years; 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24.

BACKGROUND

On September 12, 2000, the City entered into an agreement with Los Angeles County for provision of law enforcement services. The current Municipal Law Enforcement Services Agreement expired on June 30, 2019. On July 23, 2019, City Council approved Resolution No. 25,097 to allocate Twenty-Two Million, Seven Hundred Seventy Four Thousand, and Eight Hundred Sixty Four Dollars (\$22,774,864.00) to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services. However, the City was still in negotiations regarding the terms of the agreement.

STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE

In order to continue law enforcement services, the City needs to execute a new five (5) years agreement with Los Angeles County. City staff has reviewed the proposed new agreement, which provides for general law enforcement services and lays out the overall framework under which those services will be provided. The City will work with the Station Captain to address individual City priorities and goals. The Contract would remain in force until June 30, 2024. The annual contract cost authorizes a specific service level and can be increased or decreased depending on City needs. The contract cost covers the sworn personnel, Station Captain and clerical support. The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department provides vehicles, equipment, furniture, etc.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

By taking this action, the Council will not increase the City's financial obligation for this Fiscal Year. Los Angeles County Sheriff services for this fiscal year have already been approved and will be paid from FY 2019-2020 budget in Account No. 1001-680-000-4271 in the amount of \$18,714,607.00 and 1004-680-000-4271 in the amount of \$4,060,257.00 for a total of \$22,774,864.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into a municipal law enforcement services agreement with the Los Angeles County for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2024.
