

ORDINANCE NO. 03-02

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 00-08 WHICH ESTABLISHED PAY RANGE ASSIGNMENTS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR THE VARIOUS OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND POSITIONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE CITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS

FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Ordinance 00-08 shall be amended to read as

follows:

D. City Council

Medical benefits for Retired Council Members - Council Members who

served a minimum of two terms, or eight (8) years, and who retire after April 1, 2003, but not until achieving 55 years of age, and who make periodic payments, or lump sum payment, in the amount of \$10,800, will, in exchange for said \$10,800, have the City pay one hundred percent of the medical premium for the retiring Council Member and spouse.

Council Members who served in three terms, and who retire after April 1, 2003, but not until achieving 55 years of age, and who make periodic payments, or lump sum payment, in the amount of \$8,500, will, in exchange for said \$8,500, have the City pay one hundred percent of the medical premium for the retiring Council Member and spouse.

Council Members who served in four or more terms, and who retire after April 1, 2003, but not until reaching 55 years of age, and who make periodic payments, or lump sum payment, in the amount of \$6,500, will, in exchange for said \$6,500, have the City pay one hundred percent of the medical premium for the retiring Council Member and spouse.

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Council Member will be required to elect this benefit within 120 days of leaving office, but cannot receive the benefit prior to achieving 55 years of age. In the event a Council Member predeceases his or her spouse, this benefit will continue to accrue to the surviving spouse. In the event of the death of both Council Member and spouse prior to the commencement of benefits, the benefit will be forfeited.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and to its approval by the City Council and shall cause the same to be published in accordance with the City Charter; and thirty days from the final passage and adoption this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.


